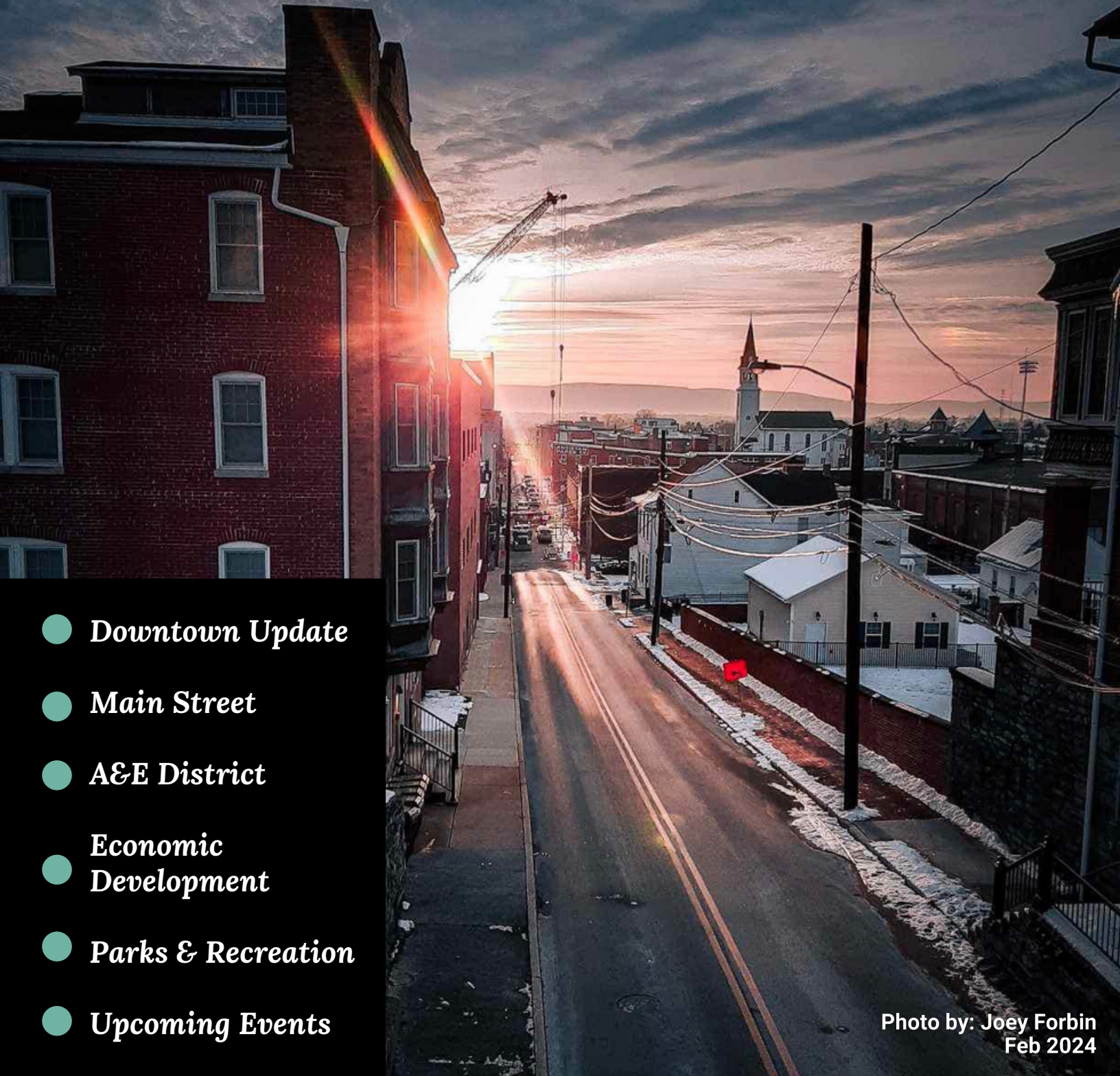

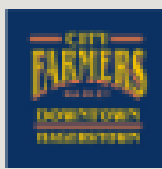

Positioned minutes from the intersection of I-70 and I-81, this new location is set to serve as the cornerstone of WebstaurantStore's northeast distribution network. WebstaurantStore, offers online sales and international distribution of over 420,000 food service, janitorial, and industrial products. WebstaurantStore is planning to invest millions of dollars in material handling and automated storage and retrieval systems at Currwood.

HAGERSTOWN YOUTH COUNCIL MEMBER SPOTLIGHT



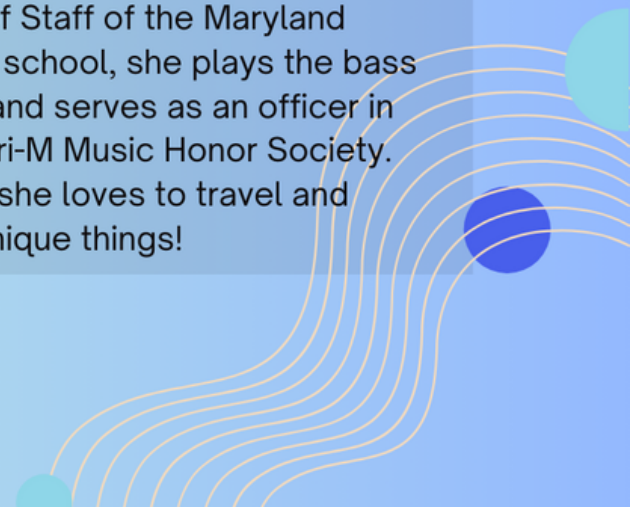
NICOLAS

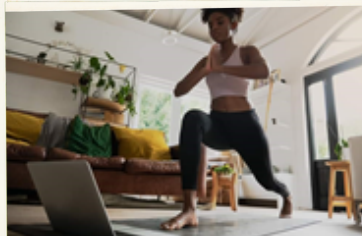
